


Application Process

To be considered for the position of Council Representative for District 1, you must have lived in the District for at least one year and be a registered voter.

1. Prepare a statement of interest as to why you would like to serve on Council;
2. Prepare a resume showing employment history, civic service, and any other pertinent information;
3. Submit these to the Council Clerk at City Hall by Monday, January 19th at 4:30pm;
4. Be available for an interview (tentatively set for Saturday, Jan. 24th.) through the end of the month.

Appointment to the office is done by a majority vote of the six current members. If a tie, Mayor appoints.
