That's why we passed legislation for ethical bidding on sizable projects. We also passed a law to add a layer of scrutiny over smaller contracts exceeding two thousand dollars.

I want to establish an Economic Development Task Force to focus on our master zoning plan, tax credits and incentives to businesses to locate here.
